





Photocopiables Teaching Notes

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Photocopiable 43, Unit 5, Vocabulary 1

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They look at the pictures and use the words in the word box to complete the crossword puzzle. In pairs, pupils compare their completed puzzles and check their answers.

Photocopiable 44, Unit 5, Vocabulary 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They label the picture using the words and phrases in the word box.

Photocopiable 45, Unit 6, Vocabulary 1

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils look at the photos of food items and write the missing letters to complete the words.

Activity 2: Pupils draw different food items from Activity 1 in each square in the Bingo grid.

First, play Bingo with the whole class. Say the names of the food items, at random. Pupils cross them out on their Bingo grids. The first pupil to cross out all the words says *Bingo!* and is the winner. Then pupils play the Bingo game in pairs.

Photocopiable 46, Unit 6, Vocabulary 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They circle the words in the spiral around the plate. Then they label the photos using the words they have circled.

Photocopiable 47, Unit 7, Vocabulary 1

Pupils work in pairs. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pair and ask them to cut out the cards. They shuffle the cards and spread them face-down on the desk. Pupils take turns to turn over two cards at a time and say both the words. The goal is to find matching pairs of cards. When a player finds a pair, the player takes the pair. The winner is the player with the most pairs at the end of the game. If the cards don't match, the player turns them face-down again, leaving them in the same place.



Photocopiable 48, Unit 7, Vocabulary 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They use the code to write clothes words. Then they match the words and the pictures.

Photocopiable 49, Unit 8, Vocabulary 1

Activity 1: Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They label the picture using the words from the word box.

Activity 2: Pupils work in teams. Ask questions about the family in the house. The first team to give a correct answer scores a point, e.g. *Where's granny/mum/dad/etc.?* Pupils should answer from memory. They shouldn't refer to their labelled pictures.

Photocopiable 50, Unit 8, Vocabulary 2

Pupils work in pairs. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil and ask them to cut out the cards. They shuffle their picture cards together and place them face-up on the desk. Then they shuffle their word cards together and take twelve cards each, at random. Each pupil puts their twelve cards in a pile face-down in front of them. They turn over their top cards and match them with the pictures as quickly as possible. When they have made a set of three (picture + two word cards), they take the set and put it in front of them. The aim is to collect as many sets as possible.

Photocopiable 51, Unit 5, Grammar 1

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They look at the pictures and read the questions and answers. They tick () the correct answer. They need to distinguish between the correct animal words and/or singular and plural forms.

Photocopiable 52, Unit 5, Grammar 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They read the descriptions and match them to the animals in the picture.



Photocopiable 53, Unit 6, Grammar 1

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils read the sentences and match them with the children.

Activity 2: They draw a happy face or sad face next to each food item, to show if they like it or not. Then they circle to make true sentences.

Photocopiable 54, Unit 6, Grammar 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils read the questions and answers and use the information to draw happy faces or sad faces in the table.

Activity 2: They trace the questions. Then they write short answers that are true for themselves.

Photocopiable 55, Unit 7, Grammar 1

Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. In pairs, they look at the weather map of the UK. They take turns to point at different places on the map and talk about the weather there. Then they work on their own to read the questions. They circle to make correct answers.

Photocopiable 56, Unit 7, Grammar 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils follow the balloon strings to match the children to the correct balloons. They read the sentences and colour the children's clothes.

Activity 2: On the outline, they draw the clothes they are wearing today. Then they circle to make true sentences.

Photocopiable 57, Unit 8, Grammar 1

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They look at the picture, read the questions and circle to make correct answers.



Photocopiable 58, Unit 8, Grammar 2

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. They look at the pictures and match the sentence parts to make true sentences about each picture.

Photocopiable 59, Unit 5, Communication game, Make a strange animal

Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil. Pupils work on their own to cut out the animal body parts. They may like to colour them first. They mix up the body parts and put a head, a body and legs together to make a strange animal of their choice. Then pupils work in pairs, back to back or separated by a book. Student A describes their strange animal to their partner (*It's got a small head. It's got feathers. It's got two legs.*). Student B has to recreate that animal. Then they swap roles.

Photocopiable 60, Unit 6, Communication game, Class survey

Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils work on their own to look at the photos and draw a happy face or sad face in the first column of faces.

Activity 2: In groups of four, pupils take turns to interview the other group members. They ask each group member, one by one, questions about each of the items in the photos, e.g. *Do you like (apples)?* to elicit *Yes, I do. / No, I don't*. They draw happy faces and sad faces to complete the column for that group member. The activity is finished when everyone in the group has completed all the columns in their tables.

Photocopiable 61, Unit 7, Communication game, Spot the difference!

Cut the worksheets in half and give half the class the worksheet for Pupil A and half the class the worksheet for Pupil B. In pairs, pupils sit back to back and, following the model, take turns to describe their pictures. The aim is to find five more differences, without looking at each other's pictures. The first pair to finish goes to the front of the class, to show their pictures to the class and to talk about the differences.



Photocopiable 62, Unit 8, Communication game, Similarities

Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils work on their own to cut out the cards for the family members and objects. They should stick them onto the picture of the house, choosing where to put the objects and what each person is doing.

Activity 2: In pairs, pupils sit back to back and, following the model, take turns to ask and answer questions about each other's houses. The aim is to find out if there are any similarities between the houses, without looking at each other's pictures. Then ask pupils to talk about the similarities, e.g. *My mum's in the garage. / My mum's in the garage, too.*

Photocopiables 63-66, Units 5-8, Songs

Pupils can use these worksheets for further vocabulary practice with the text of the song.

- In every unit, pupils listen to the song and simultaneously do the corresponding task: trace, circle or write the target words.
- You may wish to use the worksheet to check pupils' retention of the song. Pupils first complete the task, then listen to the song and check.
- The procedure for the Songs worksheets is the same for all units.

Photocopiables 67–70, Units 5–8, Stories

Pupils can use the sets of mini-story cards for each unit in various ways.

- **Hold up the picture**. Pupils have one set of story cards each or one set between pairs. Play the story recording again. Pupils listen and hold up the correct story card.
- **Sequencing**. Pupils have one set of story cards each or one set between pairs or small groups. Play the story recording again. Pupils listen and put the story cards in the correct sequence. Alternatively, they sequence the story cards first, then listen and check if they were correct.
- **Matching**. Make enough sets of story cards so that each pupil in the class has got at least one card. Distribute the cards to the class. Pupils have to arrange themselves into story groups, making sure that they have got all the frames for a story. They then put the story frames in the correct order. (Note that some pupils may need to have more than one story card, so that all the stories are complete.)
- **Completing speech bubbles.** Pupils make and write the speech bubbles, using the story text in the PB or words on the board to help them.
- The procedure and suggested activities for the mini-story cards are the same for all units.

Photocopiables 75-78, Units 5-8, English in action

Pupils can use the sets of pictures as 'realia' when they practise the English in action dialogues from the Class Book.

- In Photocopiable 77, pupils have one set of cards each or one set between pairs. As they practise the dialogue on Class Book page 44, they choose the corresponding picture cards to represent the blue or green word in the dialogue.
- The procedure for the English in action cards is the same for all units.

Photocopiable 79, Learning Club 3, CLIL

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils label the photos, using words from the word box. They write other clothes words they know.

Answer key 1 skirt **2** jacket **3** T-shirt **4** dress

Activity 2: Pupils draw and colour clothes. They write the price on the price tag.

Example answer 1 What would you like? I'd like a blue T-shirt. How much is it? It's ten rials.

Photocopiable 80, Learning Club 4, CLIL

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.

Activity 1: Pupils tick or cross to show if they can or can't do the activity.

Activity 2: Pupils write sentences about activities they can do and can't do.

Photocopiable 81, Unit 5, Sounds and spelling

Pupils work on their own. Give a copy of the worksheet to each pupil.
