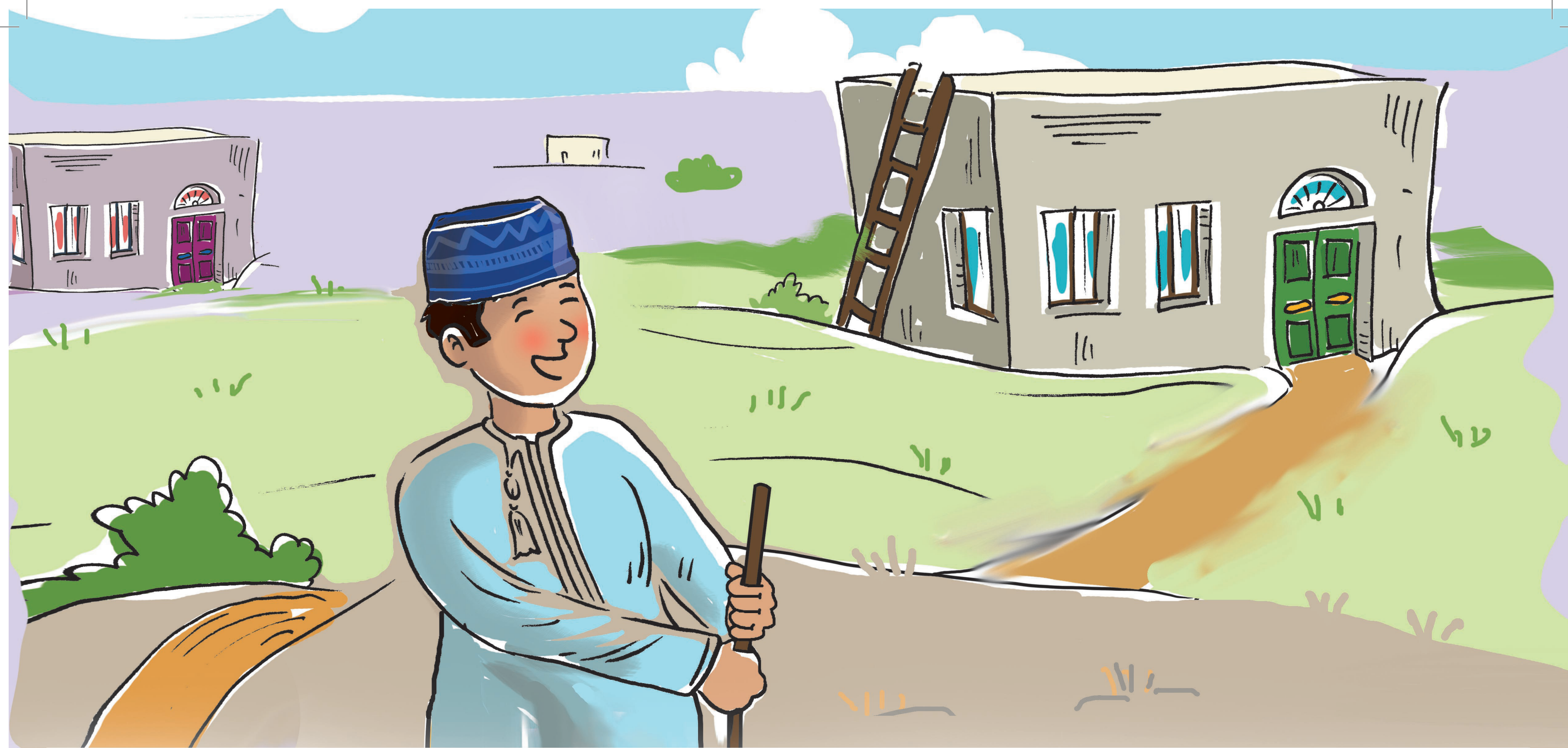

# My Blue Cap





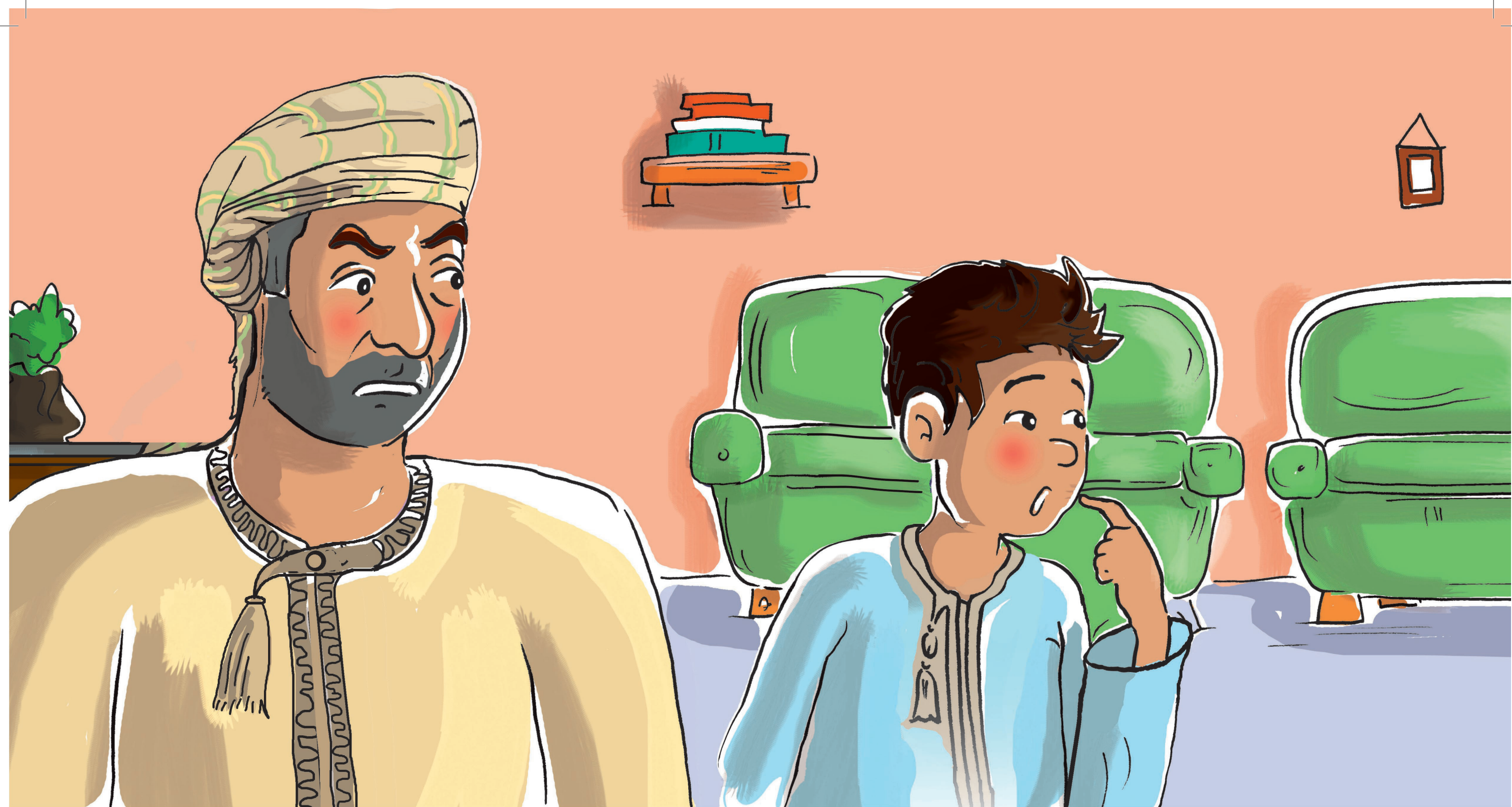
Ahmed has a blue cap.

He wears it every Friday.





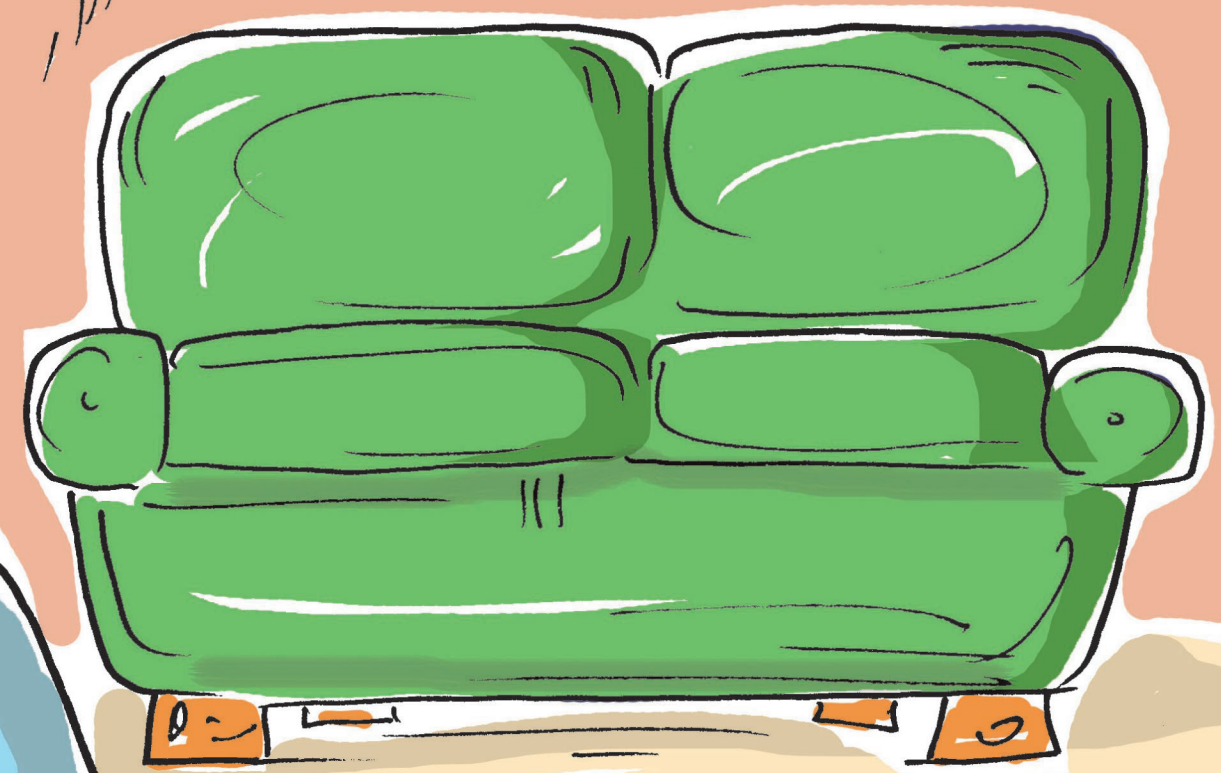
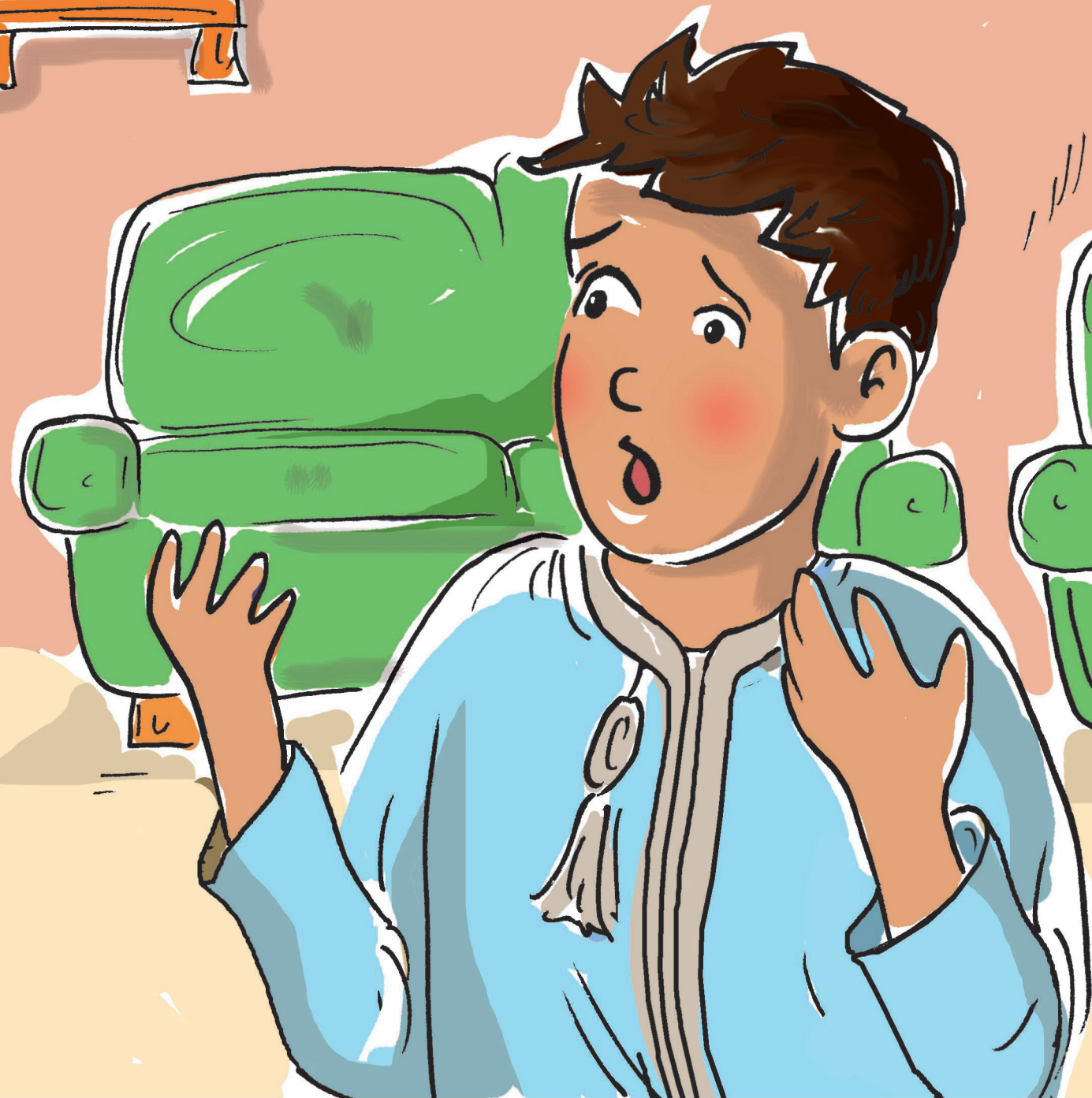
Dad calls Ahmed for prayers.

says Ahmed.





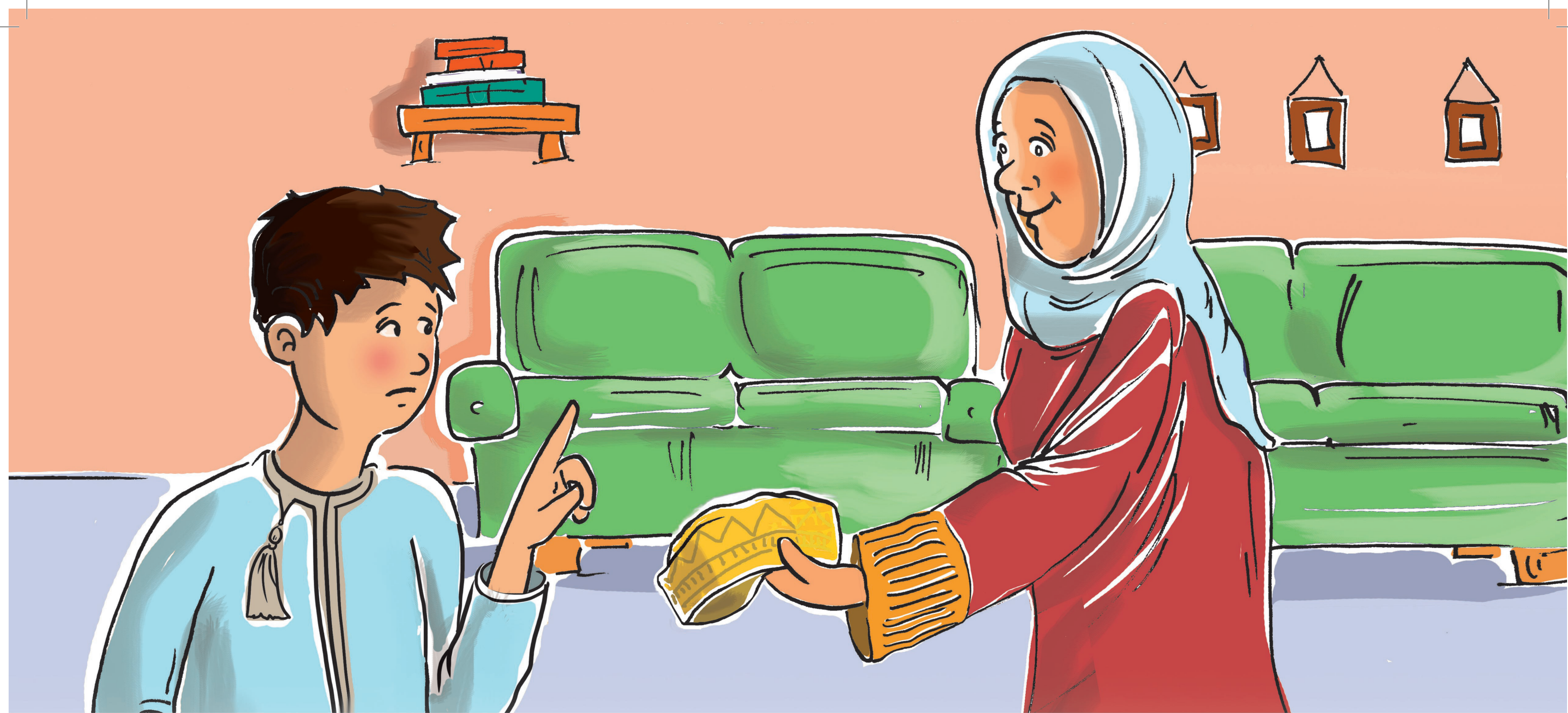
'Ahmed, it is prayer time,' says dad.





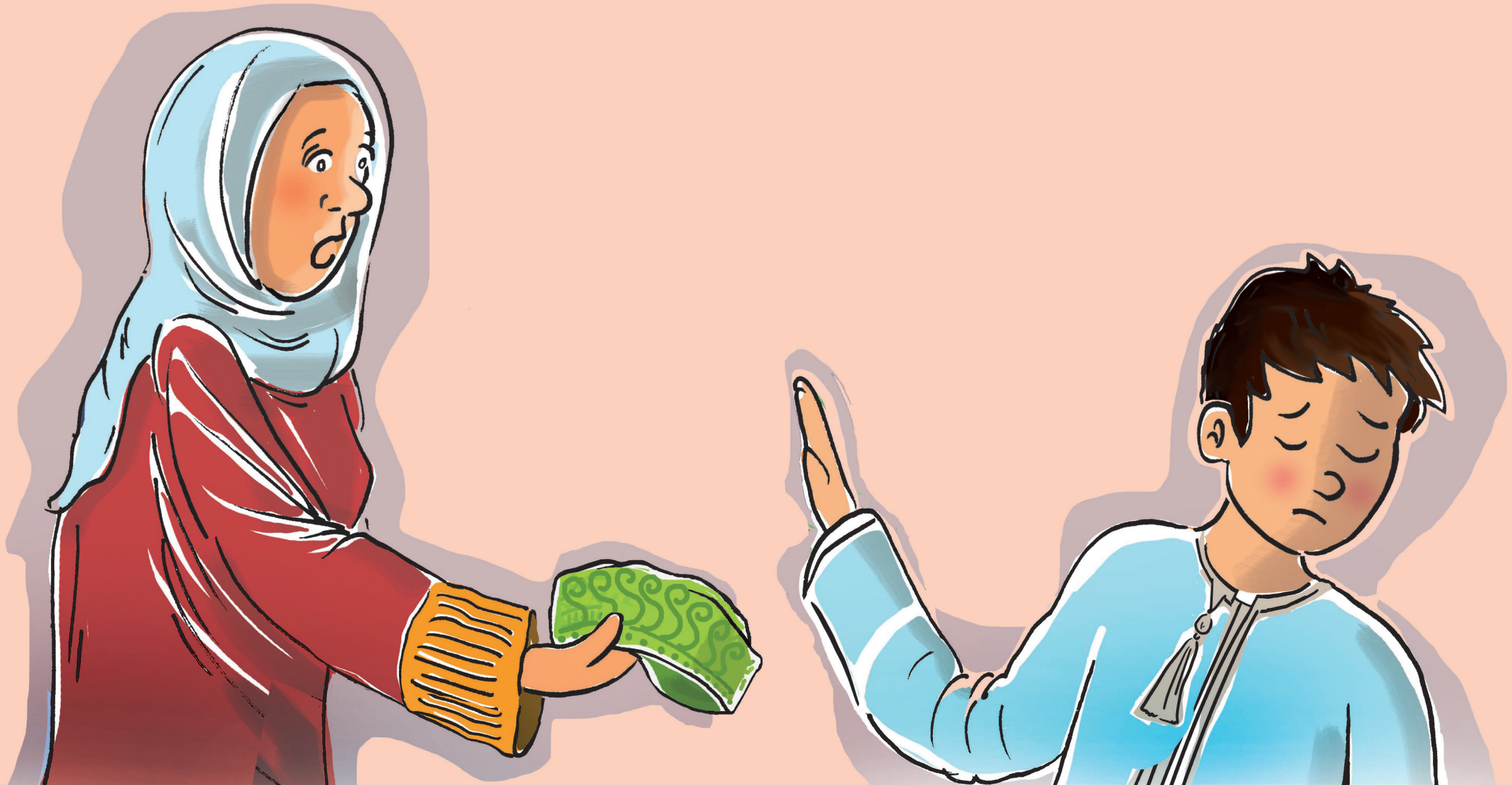
'But I can't find my blue cap,'  
says Ahmed.





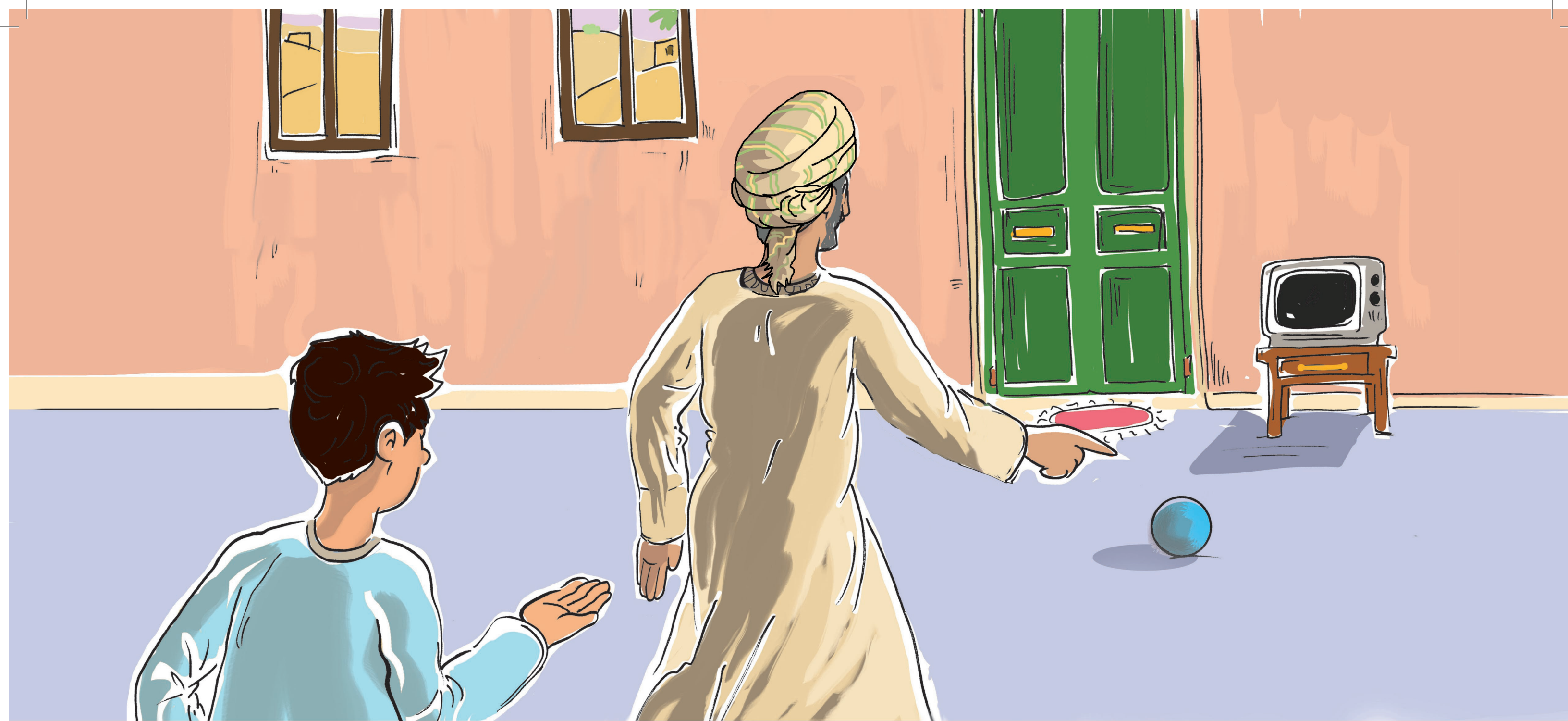
'Here is a yellow cap,' says mum.

says Ahmed.





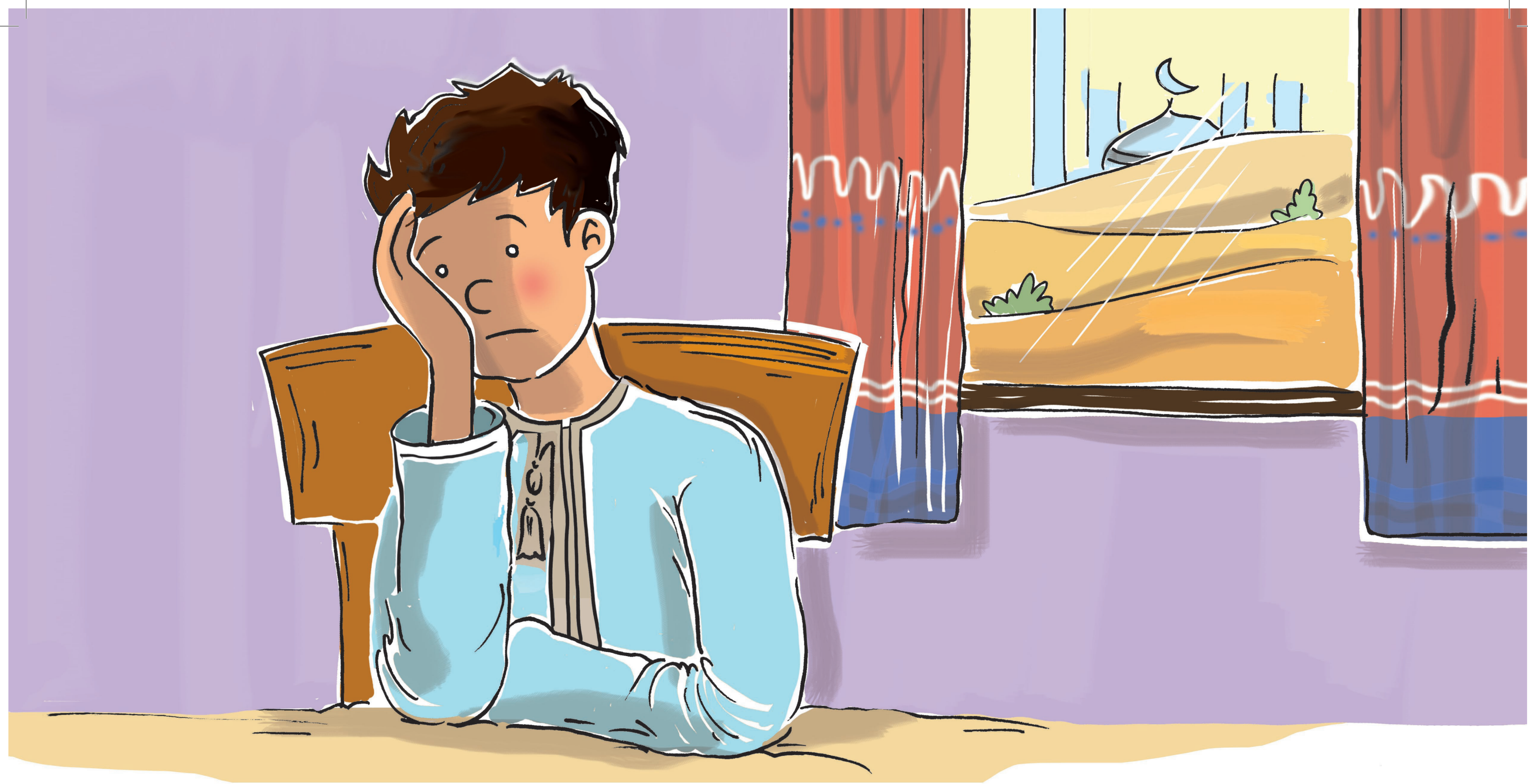
'Here is a green cap,' says mum.

says Ahmed.





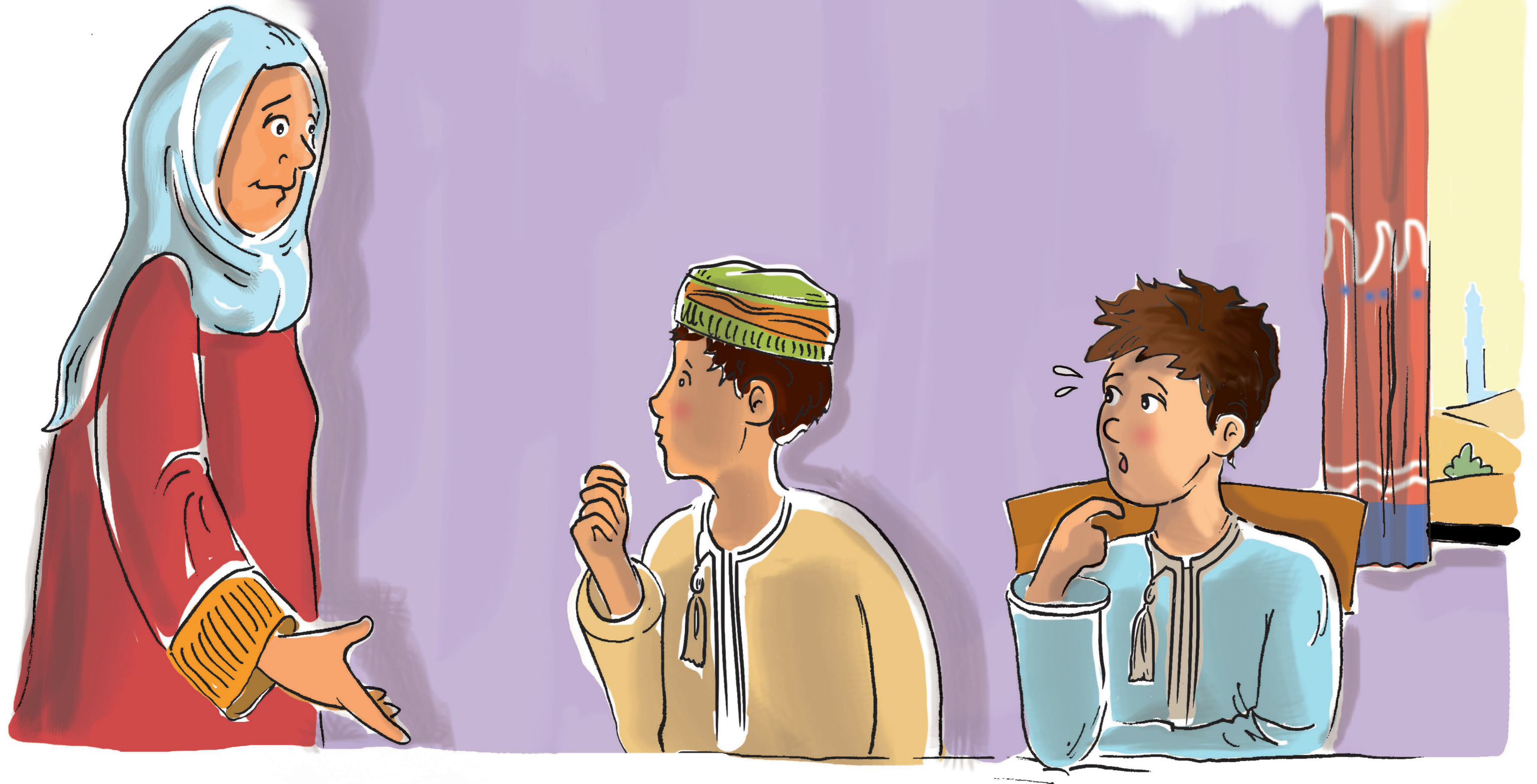
'Where is my blue cap?'  
says Ahmed.





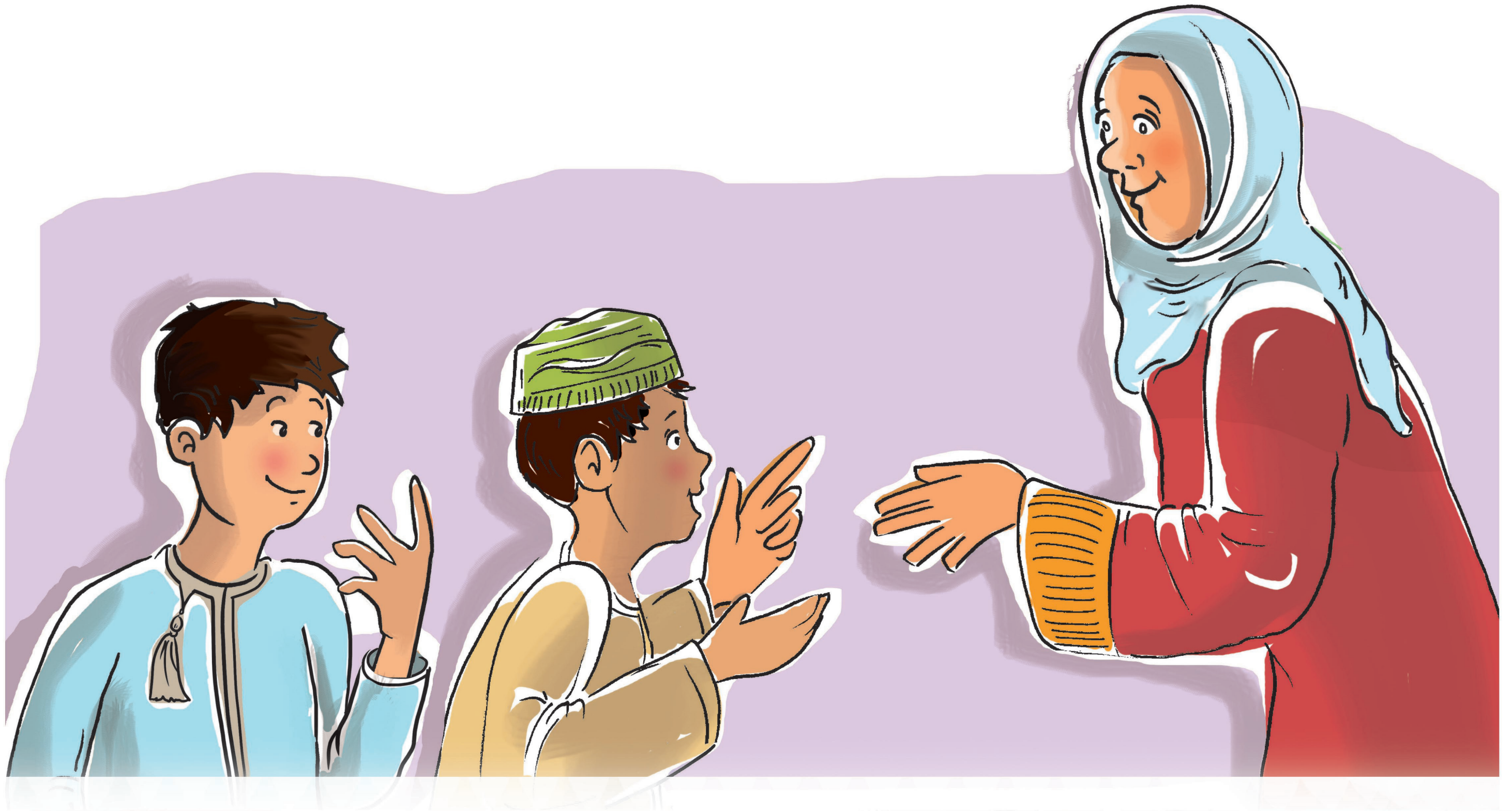
'Is it in the bedroom?'

'My lovely blue cap!' he says.





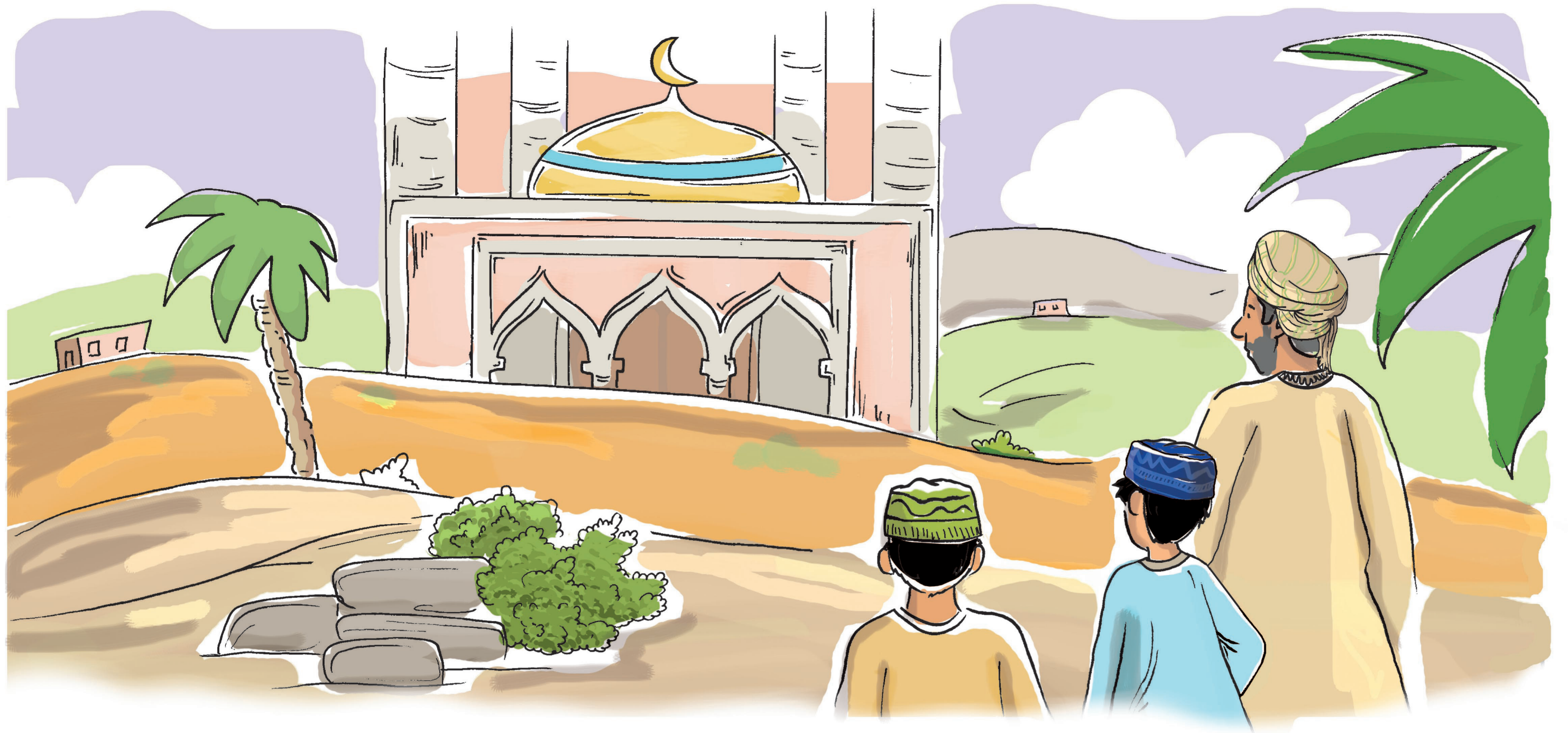
Ahmed puts on his blue cap.
