- Draw pupils' attention to the opening illustration on Class Book page 10 or Unit 5 poster ('Hobbies'). What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Can you remember five hobbies and sports?
- It's time for a story. The title of the story is The activity day.
- What can you do on an activity day? [You can try new hobbies and sports.]
- What do you think happens in the story? [Open discussion.]
- Why do you think that? [Open discussion.]

5.2

Fatma: OK, what shall we do first? I want to play chess and paint. I want to go climbing, too.

Lottie: I'd rather go windsurfing. But I can go climbing, too.

Fatma: OK, let's go climbing first!

Sami: Good idea!

- What does Fatma want to do? [She wants to play chess and paint.]
- Who wants to go climbing? [Fatma.]
- What does Lottie want to do? [Windsurfing.]
- What are they going to do first? [Climbing.]
- Does Sami think climbing is a good idea? [Yes, he does.]







What are Fatma, Lottie and Sami doing in the picture? [They're climbing.]

• Who talks to Bo in the picture? [Lottie.]

Do you think Lottie likes climbing? [Open discussion.]

5.2

Lottie: This is hard work!

Bo: You can climb very well, Lottie! But why are you breathing loudly and quickly?

Lottie: Well, when I exercise, my heart goes faster. I need more air, so I breathe more loudly

and more quickly.

After listening

• What does Lottie say about climbing? [It's hard work.]

Does Bo think Lottie can climb well? [Yes, he does.]

What happens when Lottie exercises? [Her heart goes faster.]

Why does she breathe more loudly and more quickly? [Because she needs more air.]





How many people are in the picture? [Four.]

• What can Bo do? [He can fly.]

• What does Bo see? [A bird.]

5.2

Bo: I can exercise and I can fly! I can breathe loudly, too!

Bo: What's that?

After listening

• What can Bo do? [He can exercise and he can fly.]

Can he breathe loudly? [Yes, he can.]

What does Bo ask? [What's that?]





How many people are there in the picture? [Five.]

• What is next to Bo in the picture? [A bird.]

What are the people looking at? [They're looking at the bird.]

5.2

Sami: Oh, no! It's a baby bird! It can walk but it can't fly to its nest.

Bo: What's a nest?

Fatma: It's a house for birds! The bird can't get back to its nest. Sami, can you see the nest?

After listening

• What kind of bird can they see? [A baby bird.]

What can the bird do? [It can walk.]

What can't the bird do? [It can't fly to its nest.]

What's a nest? [It's a house for birds.]





Who is in the picture? [Sami and Fatma.]

Where is the bird's nest? [On top of the climbing frame.]

• What is in the nest? [Open discussion/The mother bird is in the nest.]

5.2

Sami: Look! Here's the nest!

Fatma: Bo, can you bring the baby bird up to the nest?


After listening

What can Sami see? [The bird's nest.]

Who is Fatma talking to? [Bo.]

• What does Fatma ask Bo to do? [To bring the baby bird up to the nest.]







- Who can you see in the picture? [Bo, the mother bird and the baby bird.]
- Where is the mother bird? [In the nest.]
- What is Bo holding? [The baby bird.]



Bo: Here you are, little bird!

- Where is Bo? [At the top of the climbing frame.]
- What does Bo do? [He gives the baby bird to its mother.]
- Is the mother bird happy? [Yes, she is.]



A few minutes later ...





- Where is Bo? [On the ground/grass / At the bottom of the climbing frame.]
- Is Bo climbing? [No, he isn't.]
- What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion/A footprint.]



Narrator: A few minutes later...

Bo: What's this? Is this a house for birds, too?

- Can Bo see a nest? [No, he can't.]
- What is Bo doing? [Open discussion.]
- What does Bo find? [Open discussion.]







- Who is in the picture? [Bo.]
- What is he doing? [He is falling.]
- Can he get out? [No, he can't.]



Bo: Help! I can't get out!

- What does Bo do? [He falls in the hole.]
- Can Bo get out of the hole? [No, he can't.]
- What does Bo want? [He wants help.]







- Who is in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Where is Bo? [Open discussion.]
- Is he happy? [No, he isn't.]



Bo: Ah! Help! A monster! There's a monster! HELP!

- What does Bo think is in the hole? [A monster.]
- What does Bo do? [He shouts for help.]
- Can he get out of the hole? [No, he can't.]







Who is in the picture? [Sami, Lottie, Fatma and Bo.]

What can they see? [Open discussion/They can see a hole in the ground.]

What else can you see? [Animal footprints.]

5.2

Sami: Here you are!

Lottie: What's Bo talking about? A monster? What animal lives there?

After listening

Who helps Bo? [Sami.]

• Is there a monster in the hole? [No, there isn't.]

What does Lottie ask? [What animal lives there?]

What animal do you think lives there? [A rabbit.]





- Draw pupils' attention to the opening illustration on Class Book page 32 or Unit 6 poster ('Our town').
 What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Can you remember ten places in the town?
- It's time for a story. The title of the story is The flood.
- What happens in a flood? [A lot of water comes into the town.]
- What do you think happens in the story? [Open discussion.]




Fatma:

Hey, Lottie, come and help us with our Social Studies project! It's about our town

150 years ago.

- What does Fatma want Lottie to do? [She wants her to help with a project.]
- What project are they doing? [A Social Studies project.]
- What is the project about? [It's about their town 150 years ago.]
- Where is Bo? [Under the table.]





Who is in the picture? [Sami, Fatma and Lottie.]

What do you think they are looking at? [Open discussion/An old map of the town.]

• Do you think the town is the same or different now? [Open discussion/It's different now.]

6.2

Sami: I was at the bookshop yesterday. I've got these books and these old maps.

Fatma: That's interesting! The train station and mosque were here 150 years ago, but the

zoo and the shopping mall weren't. They're modern.


After listening

Where was Sami yesterday? [At the bookshop.]

What has he got? [He's got books and old maps.]

Was the train station and the mosque here 150 years ago? [Yes, they were.]

Are the zoo and the shopping mall old or modern? [They're modern.]







What places in the town can you see on the map? [The train station, the mosque and the café.]

Where is the mosque? [It's between the train station and the café.]

What is a wadi? [A wadi is a river that is usually dry except when it rains.]

6.2

Lottie: There was a wadi in our town 150 years ago! Where is it now?

Sami: It's underground now, under the roads.

After listening

• What was there in the town 150 years ago? [A wadi.]

Where is it now? [It's underground/under the roads.]

• Can you see the wadi now? [No, you can't.]






- Who and what can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- What are they watching? [They're watching the news.]
- What do you think the man is saying? [Open discussion.]



Engineer: '... there's a deep flood in the town, next to the cafe. We don't know why ...'

- Is there a flood? [Yes, there is.]
- Where is it? [In the town, next to the café.]
- Do they know why there is a flood? [No, they don't.]
- Why do you think there is a flood? [Open discussion.]







- Who is in the picture? [Fatma and Sami.]
- What is Fatma looking at? [She's looking at the old map.]
- What is she pointing at? [A wadi on the map.]



Fatma: Hey! Look at this map! 150 years ago, there was a wadi next to the café!

- What was next to the café? [A wadi.]
- When was there a wadi next to the café? [150 years ago.]
- Is there a wadi next to the café now? [No, there isn't.]







Do the Discovery Team know where the wadi is now? [Yes, they do.]

What do you think they can do to help the problem? [Open discussion.]

• Why are they riding their scooters? [Open discussion.]

6.2

Sami: Yes! That wadi is underground now. Maybe the wadi is the problem.

Lottie: We must tell someone! Come on!

After listening

What does Sami think? [He thinks maybe the wadi is the problem.]

• Why is there a flood? [Because of the underground wadi.]

• What must they do? [They must tell someone.]







- Where are the Discovery Team? [In the town centre.]
- Who can you see in the picture? [Sami, Fatma, Lottie, Bo and three men.]
- Where is the flood? [The flood is near the café.]
- What does Bo do? [Open discussion.]



Lottie: Bo, go and look! Be very quiet!

- What does Lottie tell Bo to do? [She tells Bo to go and look.]
- What does Bo do? [He jumps in the water.]
- Why must Bo be very quiet? [Open discussion.]







What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

Who is talking in the picture? [Bo and Lottie.]

Where was Bo? [He was under the ground.]

What do you think was under the ground? [The wadi.]

6.2

Bo: I was very quiet!

Lottie: And ... what was down there?

Bo: The wall is broken. The wadi is coming out. It was very noisy!

After listening

Was Bo very quiet? [Yes, he was.]

What is under the ground? [The wadi.]

• What is the problem? [The wall is broken and the wadi is coming out.]

Is the wadi quiet or noisy? [It's noisy.]

• What do you think Lottie tells the man? [Open discussion.]

What's the man's job? [Open discussion.]

Lottie: Excuse me. There's an underground wadi next to the cafe. The flood is coming

from there!

Man: OK, thank you!

After listening

What does Lottie tell the man? [There's an underground wadi next to the café.]

Where is the flood coming from? [From the underground wadi.]

What does the man say? [Thank you.]





- What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Do you think the men can stop the flood? [Open discussion.]
- What do think the Discovery Team can write about in their project? [The wadi and the flood.]



Sami: We were right! Well done, Discovery Team!

- Were the Discovery Team right about the flood? [Yes, they were.]
- Who says 'Well done, Discovery Team'? [Sami.]
- Can the men stop the flood? [Open discussion.]





- Draw pupils' attention to the opening illustration on Class Book page 58 or Unit 7 poster ('Historical finds'). What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Can you remember the twelve words to describe historical finds?
- It's time for a story. The title of the story is The discovery.
- Do you think there are old things in the story? [Yes/No.]
- What do you think happens in the story? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Sami: I liked the Discovery Zone! Just imagine, people lived and worked here many years

ago. There were stone houses then. People used stone from the hills to build their

houses.

Lottie: And they used clay from the ground to make jars!

Fatma: Wow! We learned a lot today, didn't we?

- What are the children learning about? [About Omani life in the past.]
- What did people do here many years ago? [They lived and worked here.]
- What did they use from the ground to make jars? [They used clay.]
- What does Fatima think about the Discovery Zone? [She thinks they learned a lot.]





Who is in the picture? [Sami, Lottie and Fatma.]

Where are they? [They are at the Discovery Zone.]

• What do they feel? [Hungry/Open discussion.]

Sami: I'm hungry.

Fatma: Me, too. Let's eat.

After listening

Who says 'I'm hungry'? [Sami.]

What does Fatma say? ['Me too.']

What are they doing? [They're eating lunch.]







• What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

What do you think Bo can do? [Open discussion.]

Who is looking at Bo? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Sami: Lottie, what are you and Bo doing?

Lottie: Bo can fly and look at things. I can see what he sees!

Fatma: Wow!

After listening

What can Bo do? [He can fly and look at things.]

What can Lottie do? [She can see what Bo sees.]

What does Fatma say? [Wow!]





What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

What is Lottie doing? [Open discussion/She's looking at her phone/tablet.]

What do you think Lottie can see? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Fatma: Look, there's a falaj for irrigation, a well ... and that's a stone wall ...

Lottie: Hey, what's that?

After listening

What is Lottie showing Fatma and Sami? [She's showing them pictures.]

• What is a falaj for? [It's for irrigation.]

What can Fatma see? [A stone wall.]





What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

• What can the Discovery Team see in the photo? [Open discussion.]

Where do you think they want to go? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Lottie: I think they're the walls of a building!

Sami: Let's go and see!

After listening

What does Lottie think is in the photo? [The walls of an old building.]

What does Sami say? [Let's go and see!]

• How do they feel? [Excited/Open discussion.]







What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

Where did the Discovery Team go? [Open discussion.]

• Where can they see? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Narrator: A few minutes later ...

Sami: People lived here a long time ago. Maybe it's an ancient building!


After listening

Did people live here a long time ago? [Yes, they did.]

What does Sami think they can see? [A building.]

• Is it a modern building or an ancient building? [An ancient building.]









What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

What are the Discovery Team doing? [Digging in the ground/Open discussion.]

What do they find? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Lottie: Look! People used silver to make jewellery. This is a piece of silver! Is it a ring?

Sami: No, it isn't! It comes from a jar.

After listening

What did people use silver for? [To make jewellery.]

What does Lottie find? [A piece of silver.]

What does Lottie think the piece of silver is? [A ring.]

Where does Sami think the silver comes from? [A jar.]







What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]

• What is Bo doing? [He is digging.]

What do they find? [An ancient jar.]

7.2

Sami: Look! It's a jar of coins! Stop, Bo! We must be careful!

Fatma: We must tell Mr Hazim at the museum!

After listening

• What is in the jar? [Coins.]

What does Sami tell Bo to do? [To stop digging.]

• Who must they tell about the jar of coins? [Mr Hazim at the museum.]





- What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Who is Fatma talking to? [Mr Hazim/A man at the museum.]
- What do you think Fatma is telling him? [Open discussion.]



Mr Hazim: Are there coins? What are they like?

Fatma: They're silver. They have writing on them.

- What does Mr Hazim ask Fatma about the coins? [What are they like?]
- What are the coins like? [They're silver.]
- What do they have on them? [Writing.]







Who can you see in the picture? [Mr Hazim, Bo and the Discovery Team.]

Where are they? [In the desert.]

What is happening in the picture? [Open discussion.]

7.2

Mr Hazim: I think these silver coins are very old!

Bo: Wow!

After listening

What does Mr Hazim think about the coins? [He thinks they are very old.]

How does Bo feel? [He is excited.]

What do you think Mr Hazim wants to do with the coins? [Open discussion.]





- Draw pupils' attention to the opening illustration on Class Book page 80 or Unit 8 poster ('Celebrations'). What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Can you remember ten words to talk about parties and funfairs?
- It's time for a story. The title of the story is The lost camera.
- What can you do at a birthday party? [Open discussion.]
- What do you think happens in the story? [Open discussion.]
- Why do you think that? [Open discussion.]


8.3

Fatma: Were there funfairs when you were young, Grandma?

Grandma: Yes, there were! I love funfairs!

Fatma: Me, too!

- What does Fatma ask Grandma? [Were there funfairs when you were young?]
- Were there funfairs when Grandma was young? [Yes, there were.]
- Did Grandma love funfairs? [Yes, she did.]





- What can you see in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- What do you think is happening? [A birthday party.]
- What do you think Grandad is saying? [Open discussion.]

8.3

Lottie: Look, there's a birthday party! They're taking photos. It's the boy's tenth birthday.

Grandad: We didn't take photos with our phones in the past. We took them with a camera.

- What does Lottie see? [A birthday party.]
- How old is the boy? [He's ten years old.]
- What are people at the party taking photos with? [They're taking photos with a phone.]
- How did Grandad take photos in the past? [With a camera.]





Who is in the picture? [Lottie, Sami, Bo and Grandad.]

• What is happening in the picture? [Open discussion.]

What do you think Bo is doing? [Open discussion.]

8.3

Sami: Bo, what are you doing?

Bo: I'm finding metal things with my metal detector!

Sami: That's great, but can you find things quietly?

After listening

What is Bo doing? [He's finding things with his metal detector.]

Is Bo noisy or quiet? [He's noisy.]

What does Sami ask him to do? [He asks him to find things quietly.]

Do you think Bo finds anything? [Open discussion.]





- Who is in the picture? [Lottie, Fatma, Grandma and Grandad.]
- What is happening in the picture? [Open discussion.]

What do you think Fatma is asking Grandma? [Open discussion.]

8.3

Fatma: Grandma, have you still got photos from when you were young?

Grandma: Yes, I have! Do you want to come and see them?

- What does Fatma ask Grandma? [Have you still got photos from when you were young?]
- Does Grandma still have photos? [Yes, she does.]
- What does Grandma say Fatma can do? [Come and see the photos.]






- What is happening in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- What is Grandma doing? [She is showing the children some photos/Open discussion.]

- Are the children excited to see the photos? [Yes, they are.]

- Where are Grandma's photos? [In a book/an album.]




Grandma: These are photos of a family party. It was my twenty-first birthday.

What do you think he is talking about? [The camera.]

How do you think they feel? [Sad.]

Grandad: But we lost the camera a few years later.


Sami: Oh, no!

After listening

• What happened to do the camera? [They lost it.]

Did they lose the camera at the party? [No. They lost it a few years later.]

What does Sam say about the lost camera? [Oh no!]

- What is Fatma asking Grandma? [Open discussion.]

Fatma: What was your camera like, Grandma? Did it have the internet?

- Did Grandma's camera have the internet? [No, it didn't.]
- Who is making a noise? [Bo.]





- What is happening in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- Who is in the picture? [Sami and Bo.]
- What is Bo doing? [Open discussion.]



Sami: What's this?

- What does Sami ask? [What's this?]
- What noise is Bo making? [Bleep! Bleep!]
- What do you think Bo finds? [Open discussion.]



That's my camera! Wow! After all those years! Well done, Discovery Team!



- What is happening in the picture? [Open discussion.]
- What has Sami got? [Grandma and Grandad's camera.]
- Are Grandma and Grandad happy? [Yes, they are.]



Grandma: That's my camera! Wow! After all those years! Well done, Discovery Team!

- Who found Grandma and Grandad's camera? [Bo.]
- How did Bo find Grandma and Grandad's camera? [With his metal detector.]
- What does Grandma say to the Discovery Team? [Wow! After all these years! Well done, Discovery Team!]
