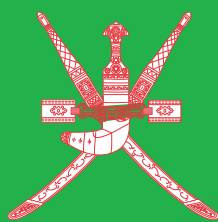

Many years ago, there was a big food market in the city. The market was near a beautiful bridge.

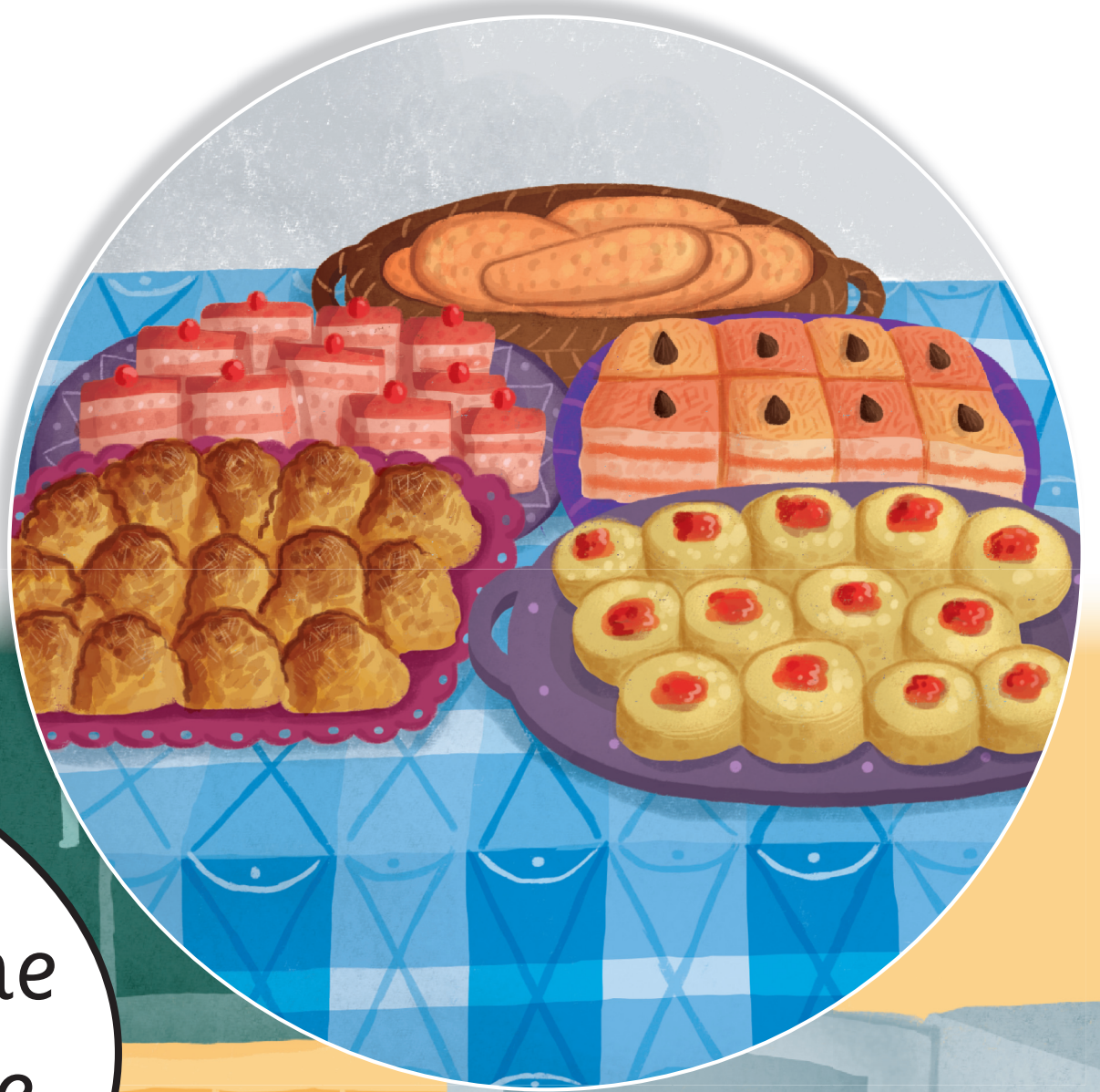


Look! There was delicious food at the old market.

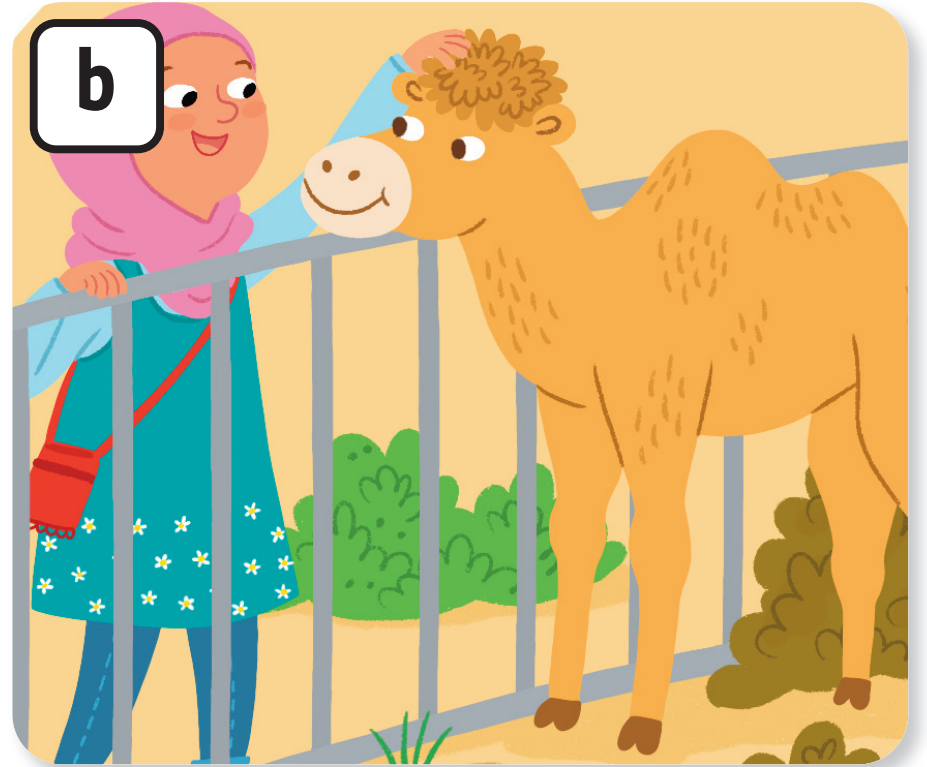

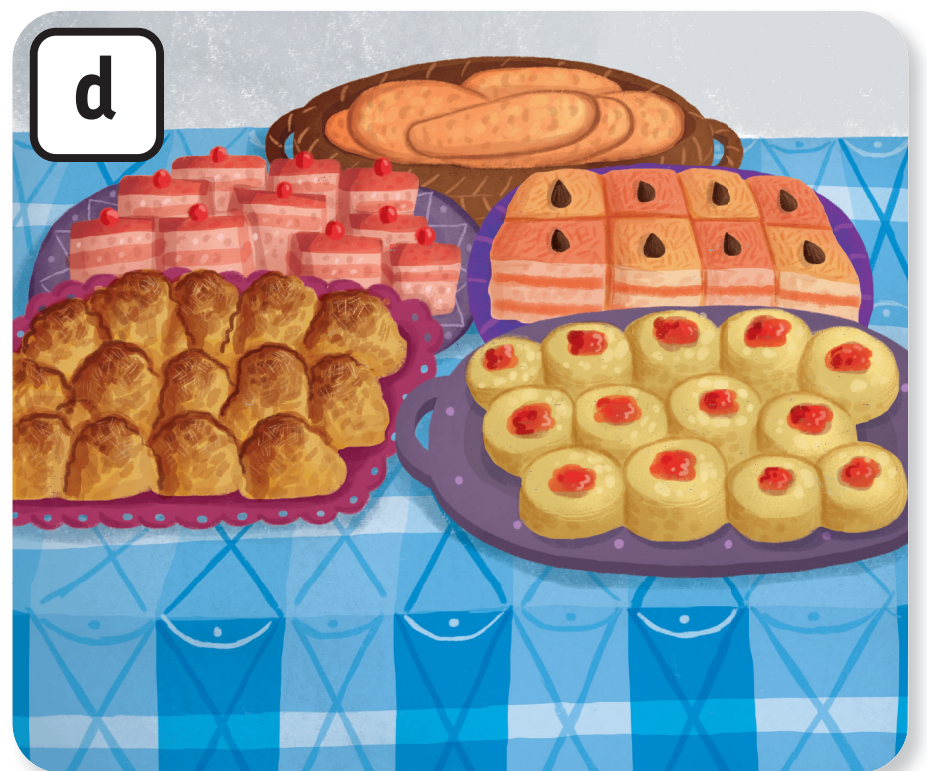
